\*Aspen shavings are a safe, comfortable, easy to clean substrate for your pet, but have a tendency to lower the humidity in the terrarium. If you are having trouble keeping the humidity up, try cypress mulch.

\*\* Live food can harm the snake by biting it before it is eaten, leaving them susceptible to infections.
